Helmet/Egg Demo	Spillage causing slip hazard	Staff and visitors	Tray / bowls and cleaning paper to be available. Location of sink and running water to be sourced.	Low
Helmet/Egg Demo	Allergy	Staff and visitors	Organisers to have list of visitors with allergies. Demonstrator to check However on the chance that just contact with egg content may cause a problem then demonstrator to ask the volunteer or adult present if there is a problem.	As there is no ingestion of the eggs it is anticipated that the risk will be extremely low
